Overwhelming majority believes mask wearing, testing, contact tracing, cleaning/sanitizing, hand washing, clean air flow, and working remotely are important. (see charts 1a and 1b)

- More than 90% believe EACH of the following is <u>important in reducing personal risk</u> (and more than two-thirds responded "<u>VERY important</u>" for those in bold italics):
  - Mask wearing of both students and employees
  - Cleaning/sanitizing of workspaces
  - Cleaning/sanitizing of bathrooms
  - Clean air flow
  - Access to hand washing facilities for the campus community
  - Access to hand sanitizer for the campus community
  - Contact Tracing
  - Others working remotely
  - Themselves working remotely
  - COVID-19 testing of students
  - o COVID-19 testing of employees
  - Use of protective barriers around work areas
  - Staggered/rotated schedules

\*\*\*\*\*\*\*

Majority concerned about NOT having the discretion to choose face-to-face or online teaching, NOT being allowed to work remotely, workload increase related to COVID-19, campus administrators refraining from sharing negative/worrisome information, and one or more stakeholder groups not being included in decision-making. (see charts 2a and 2b)

- 70% are more than a little concerned about <u>NOT being allowed to work remotely</u>, and 48% are VERY concerned
- 83% of Academics and 65% of Professionals are more than a little concerned about <u>not having discretion to choose face-to-face or online teaching</u>, and **64% of Academics and 34% of Professionals are VERY concerned**
- 86% of Academics and 66% of Professionals are more than a little concerned about <u>one or more stakeholder</u> groups not being included in decision-making, and 53% of Academics and 25% of Professionals are VERY concerned
- 78% of Academics and 60% of Professionals are more than a little concerned about <u>being unable to perform</u>
  job adequately more than 6 feet from others, and 52% of Academics and 25% of Professionals are VERY
  concerned
- 76% of Academics and 63% of Professionals are more than a little concerned about <u>campus administrators</u>
   <u>refraining from sharing information because it is negative or worrisome</u>, and 46% of Academics and 25%
   of Professionals are VERY concerned
- 81% of Academics and 61% of Professionals are more than a little concerned about <u>workload increase related</u> to COVID-19, and 46% of Academics and 21% of Professionals are VERY concerned

Many have concerns that the campus will fail to provide what is needed to decrease risk of COVID-19 transmission; and less than half believe that the campus will provide sufficient clean air flow or be able to sufficiently enforce safety policies and protocol. (see charts 3a and 3b)

- 75% believe the campus will:
  - o Provide sufficient hand washing/sanitizing access.
- Roughly just two-thirds believe the campus will:
  - o Provide adequate levels of personal protective equipment
  - Support return to remote work should it be deemed necessary by healthcare experts
  - o Provide adequate cleaning and disinfection of campus bathrooms and workspaces
- Just half believe the campus will:
  - Provide adequate contact tracing
- More than 40% do not know/disagree that the campus will:
  - o Place appropriate restrictions on communal and high-traffic areas
  - o Ensure sufficient isolation of COVID-19 positive cases
- More than half do not know/disagree that the campus will:
  - o Provide sufficient clean air flow
- Roughly two-thirds do not know/disagree that the campus will:
  - o Be able to sufficiently enforce COVID-19 safety policies and protocol.



Less than half believe campus administrators will equitably distribute work related to reopening and COVID-19; less than half believe campus administrators are allowing participatory decision-making with all stakeholder groups; and only one in four believes the campus has a plan to support a surge in demand for campus-based healthcare facilities. (see charts 4a and 4b)

- Roughly 4 in 10 do not know whether the campus has a plan to support a surge in demand for campus-based healthcare facilities to accommodate students who may become ill, and 3 in 10 do not believe the campus has a plan.
- More than half do not believe campus administrators are allowing participatory decision-making with all stakeholder groups; one-third do believe participatory decision-making is occurring (and 13% do not know).
- Roughly only 1 in 4 Academics and roughly half of Professionals believe that campus administrators will equitably distribute work related to reopening and COVID-19.
- Only 1 in 4 Academics and half of Professionals believe the campus will be supportive of employees with childcare conflicts as a result of COVID-19 school and childcare closures.
- Roughly just 1 in 3 Academics and 2 in 3 Professionals believe the campus administrators respect people's varied comfort levels with reopening.














