MESSAGE FROM FRED KOWAL, UUP STATEWIDE PRESIDENT ON JUNETEENTH

Colleagues,

As you know, Governor Cuomo issued an Executive Order yesterday, which has established June 19 — Juneteenth — as a state holiday. As such, state employees will have the day off, or will be granted a comp holiday if they are required to report to work.

Juneteenth is an incredibly important day in American history. It is the day that the last of the enslaved Americans were informed that they were free, by US military forces occupying Texas in 1865 — months after the surrender of Confederate forces at Appomattox Courthouse, Virginia. Today, as we face — I hope — a reckoning of the racist history of our nation, the holiday takes on incredible importance for all of us.

I would like to invite you to do two things. First, to register for the Poor Peoples' Campaign, a major (unfortunately virtual) event on Saturday, led by the Reverend William Barber. Though this was planned a long time ago, the timing for this event could not be better. Please take part and encourage your colleagues to do so as well. UUP will join the digital Mass Poor People's Assembly and Moral March on Washington, the largest digital gathering of poor, dispossessed and impacted people, faith leaders, and people of conscience. This 2.5 hour program will broadcast on Saturday, June 20 at 10am and 6pm, and again on Sunday, June 21 at 6pm. You can find more information, RSVP and join the event at www.june2020.org.
