Over the last couple of months, the negotiations team has met with the state. Meetings are scheduled through the remainder of the year and dates are being scheduled for 2023. UUP has completed presenting its expanded proposals to the state and currently, the state is presenting its counter-proposals in greater detail. HEALTH CARE RETENTION BONUS

As many of you are aware, distribution of the Health Care Retention Bonuses begun. UUP has fought long and hard for our members who risked their lives throughout the darkest days of the COVID pandemic. The Chapter has been working with Human Resources to ensure that every member who is entitled, receive their bonus. There is no "deadline" for when these bonuses must be paid. Please keep in mind that the retention bonus is not a union negotiated benefit and eligibility is determined by the State of New York and Downstate Medical Center. Rest assured, UUP will advocate on your behalf!

INDIVIDUAL DEVELOPMENT AWARD PROGRAM

Funding for the Individual Development Award Program ("IDA") is provided under the 2016-2022 Agreement between UUP and the State of New York. Pursuant to the 2016-2022 Agreement, funding has been extended for a nine-month period July 2, 2022 ending March 31, 2023. ALL ACTIVITIES FUNDED BY THE PROGRAM MUST BE COMPLETED BY MARCH 31, 2023!!!

The IDA Program Guidelines for the period July 2, 2022 through March 31, 2023, have been revised as follows:

Employees may be awarded a maximum of \$2,000 for the award period. Funding may be awarded for up to two projects or activities for the award period not to exceed \$2,000. Please note, there will be **no** reimbursements for consumables, nonconsumables, technology, equipment or supplies, **course fees**, books, **licensing/exam preparation** or **licensing/exam fees**. Funding will not support activities that are not related to your SUNY profession.

Application forms for the period July 2, 2022 through March 31, 2023, will be available after January 18, 2023. You will be able to access the guidelines and application on-line through our website or you can also call the chapter office at (718) 270-1519 and arrange to get a copy.

VACATION ACCRUAL EXTENSION

UUP and the state have reached an agreement to suspend the annual 40-day vacation accrual cap once again for UUPrepresented employees.


Under the agreement, UUP bargaining unit members who delayed vacation because of the emergency conditions of the pandemic can now carry their vacation days which exceed the normal 40-day cap past the Dec. 31, 2022, deadline. They can retain those accumulated days until the close of business on Dec. 31, 2023.

Without the extension, employees would have lost those vacation days—which normally expire at the end of the year.

UUP is holding its virtual pre-retirement workshops in December 2022 and January 2023.


The webinars will cover health care and Medicare, followed by union benefits, such as dental and vision coverage.
