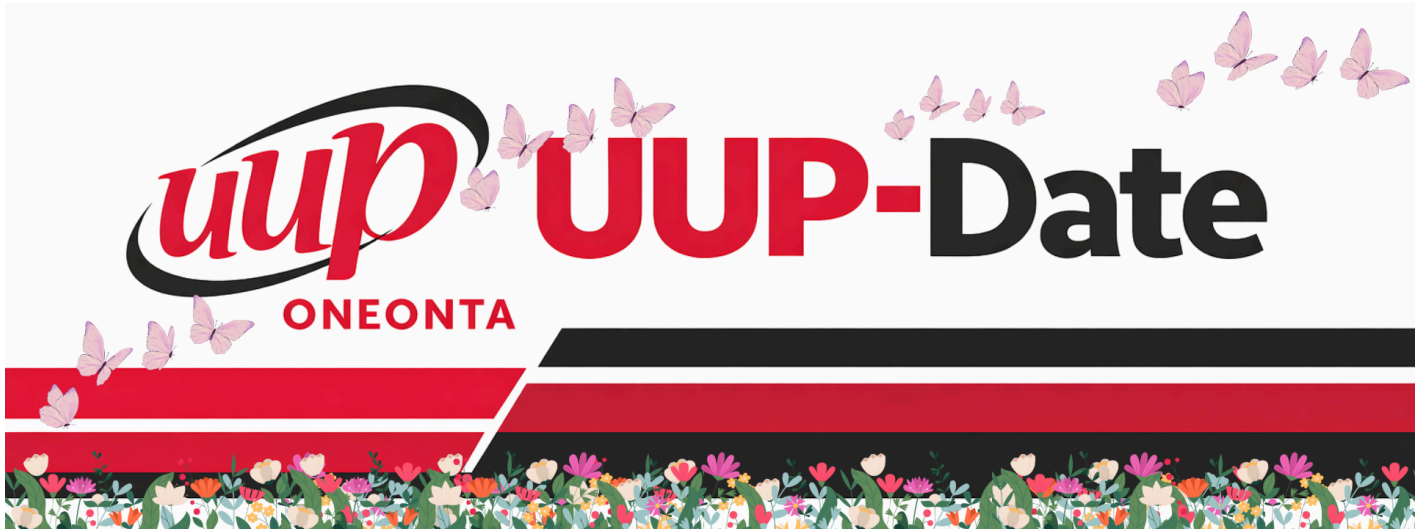

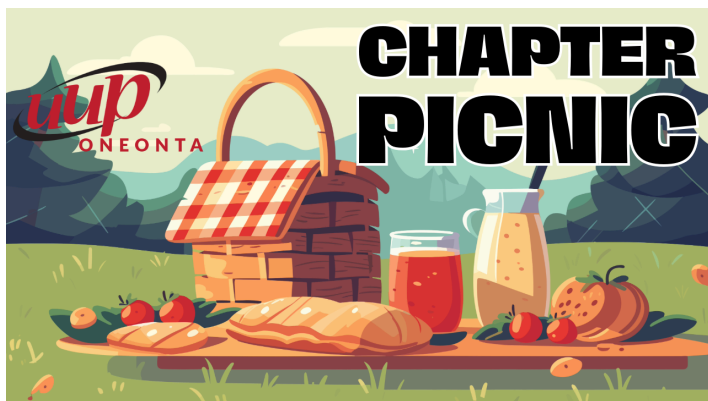

UUP Steve Street Scholarship Award

This one-time \$500 award recognizes a SUNY undergraduate student or group who has completed a paper or documented a project on a social justice topic. It is open to full and part-time students, with an application deadline date of **May 1**.

Named in honor of Steve Street, a respected UUP contingent faculty member at Brockport and Buffalo State who passed away in 2012, the award reflects his long-standing advocacy for contingent employees. Street served as an officer, delegate, and member of the statewide Contingent Employment Committee, and received UUP's 2010 Faye Samuel Award for Courageous Service by Part-Time Academic and Professional Faculty.
